# Fulghum Industries, Inc. PCA Valdosta Linerboard Mill

### Description:

BRUKS Rockwood, in cooperation with Fulghum Industries, Inc., provided the chip yard for PCA's Valdosta Linerboard Mill. This mill encompasses two (2) BRUKS Rockwood Stacker/Reclaimers and two (2) Truck Dumpers. Chips are stored with a COSR with 2,300,000 cubic feet of live storage while wood waste is stored with an OCR with 635,000 cubic feet of live storage. One Truck Receiving Station is designated for chips and the other for wood waste. Along with Fulghum Industries' chipping line, this fully automated system produces an average annual volume of over 1,400,000 tons.
